Cemetery Dues:

Our Lady of Lourdes Cemetery Board is charged with the responsibility of providing our church parish and community with perpetual care of cemetery plots for our deceased. In order to maintain our three cemeteries, we ask all OLL parishioners, plot owners and relatives of deceased to pay yearly dues to assist in lawn maintenance, fencing, roads, utilities, etc. **Since 2018, dues are assessed at \$15 per year per family.** Please understand that these dues help maintain our cemeteries for past and future deceased parishioners/relatives, i.e. perpetual care. While some of you have dutifully paid your maintenance dues, some have not yet responded for 2020. If that is so, please remit \$15 for 2020, and you may consider adding \$15 for your upcoming 2021 cemetery dues for a total of \$30. Mail your check to the OLL Cemetery Board at 1315 Egg Bend Rd.
