The choir follows the lead of Krystle Reynaud, the director and soloist. Most of the choir members have no formal music training, but with practice and dedication, their voices produce beautiful music with a meaningful message. The size of the choir varies each weekend, but every weekend you find two original members of the old church choir – Lilly Dubea and Rae Anna Laborde and whenever possible, Ellen Surek. Before Mass, Colleen Lamartiniere also leads the congregation in reciting the Rosary. We thank all the members for their dedication and time and serving the Lord through music.
