Annual Diocesan Appeal:

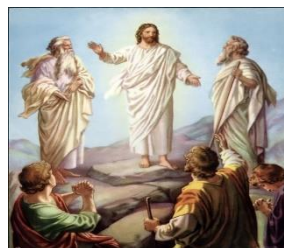
