CCD Update:

Children in second grade will make their First Communion this year. Therefore, since there are about ten students, the class will be divided in two groups. Group A will attend Wednesday evening, October 7th at 6pm and register at that time. Group B will attend Wednesday evening, October 14th at 6pm and register at that time. Masks will be worn and social distancing practiced. They will attend every Wednesday evening in rotation of groups.

Students in eleventh grade will make their Confirmation this year. There are only four candidates, so they will meet as one class on Sunday afternoon, October 11th from 3:00 – 5:00pm and register at that time. They will have class monthly, meeting only on the second Sunday of each month from 3-5pm. Masks will be worn and social distancing practiced.

There will be no CCD classes for all other grades this year. These decisions were made according to state and diocesan guidelines, and in a committee meeting which included the teachers of these classes.
