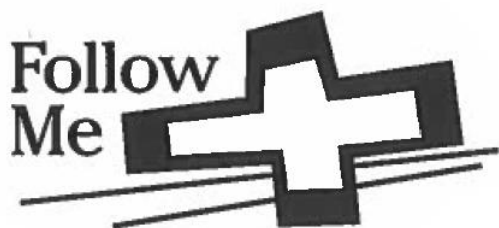

A new monument, purchased by Ronald Lemoine, was recently installed in loving memory of the deceased Lemoine family members (Sidney, Euna, Truett, and Nickey). May God grant them eternal rest. The only surviving family members are Ronald Lemoine and daughter Sydney.

*Mr. Ronald has been very attentive to the maintenance of the Grotto and repainting of the statues for a special reason. In the late 50's the original Grotto was erected in memory of Euna P. Lemoine by her husband, Mr. Sidney Lemoine (Ronald's father). It was located between the hall and the rectory. Years later Ronald Lemoine had the Grotto relocated and expanded in a more suitable location next to the Calvary Garden. Now the Grotto stands in memory of his parents, brother, and son. Thank you, Mr. Ronald, for building and maintaining the Grotto, statues, and the original statue of the Blessed Mother in front of the rectory. May God bless you.
